The reforms implemented in our country to increase the reading culture of young people are not in vain, therefore, the maturity of the future generation is determined by acquiring knowledge and being educated.

The age limit of people in this category is flexible, that is, according to the formation of the socio-psychological conditions of the reader, a 10-year-old child can be added to the category of adolescent readers depending on the unique typological characteristics, and 14-year-olds are considered to be adolescents. it will be possible to add to the list of the nature of the category. In order for reading to enter the spiritual life of a child, it is necessary to have an effective and aesthetic preparation in advance.[3]

We aim to teach primary school students to read, we have the opportunity to cover children from the above periods of 6-9 years old and 10-11 years old transitioning from childhood to adolescence. During this period, the students were very curious and active, and if the teacher could give the right direction, there was an opportunity to achieve great goals.
