Simultaneously, it was demonstrated that educators and psychologists may employ the created program for the development of individual behavior when assisting secondary school teachers.

In the study "Psychoprophylaxis and psychocorrection of the formation of the feeling of loneliness in adolescents" by N.Sh. Mullaboyeva [8], the development of the feeling of loneliness in adolescence is typified by poor communication skills, low self-esteem, and an incapacity to fit in with a group. examined for a relationship with Teenage loneliness can also be caused by a variety of

The scientific research work on "The influence of interpersonal relations in the family on the child's social perception" by G.A. Kurbanova [11] revealed, based on empirical research, that the nature of a child's communication process is influenced by interpersonal relations in the family and is dependent on feelings of sympathy or antipathy. Specifically, research has focused on how early adolescence and adolescence's distinct interpersonal interaction traits present themselves, as well as the psychological aspects of adolescent social perception.
