Description: This table presents the results of a study conducted to measure youth attitudes toward preserving national values and cultural heritage. The indicators were measured across five key


dimensions, with percentage values calculated for each. The highest results were recorded in the areas of the education system and valuing national values, while the perception of globalization's influence had the lowest percentage.

However, the study also identified challenges, particularly the growing influence of globalization (58%), which indicates that young people are increasingly exposed to external cultural influences. While such exposure is natural in a globally connected world, it highlights the need for a balanced approach that allows youth to embrace both modernity and their cultural roots. Overall, this research confirms that youth play a vital role in cultural preservation, and their engagement can be enhanced through a combined effort of education, media, and policy-making. Future efforts should focus on fostering a deeper appreciation of national values through interactive and innovative strategies, ensuring that cultural heritage remains an integral part of modern society while adapting to contemporary challenges.
