

## The Role of the New Constitution in Government

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### Abstract:

This article presents the Constitution, its dictionary meaning, tasks, the new Constitution of the Republic of Uzbekistan, changes in it, norms, speeches and views of the President in this regard.

**Keywords:** *Constitution, norm, right, law, society, state, people, youth, reforms, changes*

Since the earliest times, people have always been in communication with societies and related nations, and have established new relationships. And in these processes they were regulated by law and life norms. One of the norms regulating such societies and their actions is the Constitution.

Constitution (Latin "Constitution" - structure, arrangement [1:1]) - the Basic law of the state. It defines the structure of the state, the system of power and management bodies, their authority and the order of their formation, the electoral system, the rights and freedoms of citizens, the relationship between society and the individual, as well as the judicial system and the relationship between the state and society.

The term "Constitution" was known already in Ancient Rome (the law called "Imperial Constitution"). Amir Temur's "Tuzuklar" was a constitutional document of a special form typical of the civilization of Eastern and Asian countries. Along with Sharia laws, it had a strong influence on the fate of the peoples of the Central Asian region. It is stated in the law that if it is necessary to punish guilty, criminal persons, it is forbidden to inflict punishments such as torture, physical injury, etc. It is necessary to start him on the right path through enlightenment. Or if not, if a person of that time took care of the hilly, neglected steppe land and improved it, the first tax was not collected from him. The ideas of humanity and humanism were put forward in our grandfather's tuzuks, as well as in our national komus. In a word, today's constitution is the constitution of our independence.

Looking at the complex and important and at the same time honorable annals of the creation of our Basic Law, we are sure that the Constitution of Uzbekistan is the result of the long journey of our

people towards independence. First of all, three thousand years of national statehood experience was relied upon in the construction of the constitutional "building". Today's Uzbekistan embodies the ancient Khorezm and Sogdiana, Karakhanids, Khorezmshahs, Amir Temur and Timurids, Uzbek khanates, our enlightened ancestors, the historical traditions of our people and their centuries-old dream of an independent state. In addition, based on our interests and aspirations, our Basic Law was created taking into account the advanced constitutional experience accumulated by 97 countries of the East and West, South and North.

Thus, since the day Uzbekistan declared its independence, a new, sovereign state has been established on the world stage, and on the day of the adoption of our first Constitution, our state was reborn, and a solid legal foundation was laid for our true independence. The first Constitution of independent Uzbekistan formed and strengthened reliable, legal guarantees of the new independent society.

At the same time, our Basic Law provides and protects human rights and interests, freedom, based on the best aspects of best practice in the field of constitutional construction in many democratic countries, the universally recognized norms of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and other international documents in this field. mechanism.

The development of society depends on the constitution and its stability. The Constitution, as I mentioned above, regulates the most important and fundamental social relations. Compared to other relationships, these relationships are stable, long-lived, and do not need frequent changes. That is why constitutions are laws that are less likely to change compared to other laws. However, if we take into account that life always tends to change and move forward, social relations also change, the need to organize them anew, and the diversity of conditions in different periods creates the need to make changes to the constitution. The development of Uzbekistan, the reforms being carried out in it, are certainly causing changes in social relations. The reforms being carried out in the field of state building and management create the need to improve the composition and operation of government structures, to deepen the principle of separation of powers, and as a result, to define powers more precisely. The deepening of democratic processes, the policy of liberalization showed that there will be changes in the status of the head of state, strengthening his status as the head of the state, removing him from the structure of the executive power, and transferring some powers to the Parliament and the government. The development of political life in society depends on the activity of the participants in this process, which first of all requires increasing the role of political parties. This also required the introduction of appropriate amendments to the Constitution. Determining democratic requirements, striving to obtain positive aspects of the experience of world statehood can also lead to amendments to the constitution.

The newly revised Constitution for this purpose is a vital necessity arising from the evolutionary development of the society of Uzbekistan, and this work is an extremely important issue for us to determine our next steps as a country, a nation and a people, a huge step towards building a just society.

We have achieved our achievements in the last six years, in particular, the removal of hundreds of restrictions in the areas of economy, human rights, justice, freedom of speech and religion, social protection, solving problems in cash, currency, credit issues, working with our neighbors. it is necessary to ensure the constitutional protection of several years of "ice melting" between us and other positive actions. In order for these achievements, rights and freedoms to be freely used not only by our present, but also by our future generations, it is necessary to seal them in the Constitution.

We are all witnessing that unexpected dangers and threats are emerging in the world every day. It is impossible to predict when and how today's conflicting processes and economic conflicts will end.

It is not a secret that the question of whether some countries will remain on the world map is under question. Nearly 100 million people in the world are looking for shelter in other countries to save their lives. It seriously makes us think that it is impossible not to have an effect on us as well. In addition, the situation in our region does not stop us from worrying, unrest has been going on in our region for almost 50 years.

If we pay attention, our country is becoming a big country in every aspect. Our population is expected to reach 50 million by 2040, and of course, half of the population in our society will be young people. In order to create decent living conditions for them, there should be a stable economy, a safe state, effective management, and social guarantees. The solution to these and similar problems requires a solid legal foundation - the new Constitution of Uzbekistan.

It should be noted that this new version of the Constitution was created by scientists and specialists not only in the cabinets. Perhaps, at first, the opinions and proposals of our people were studied in two stages, and only after that the draft Constitution was prepared. Earlier, when adopting the Constitution, a draft was first developed, and then it was put to the people's discussion.

- In the first stage: citizens submitted more than 60,000 proposals for the drafting of the Constitution. About one in four of them got a place in the project;
- At the second stage: the draft Constitution was put to public discussion. 5 million residents got acquainted with the project through mass media and Internet networks, and more than 150 thousand suggestions and comments were made.

At the same time, about 10,000 additional proposals were received during discussions with labor unions, universities, neighborhood activists and intellectuals. Also, international legal documents and the experience of more than 190 countries were studied, and the project was subjected to 6 types of expertise. All this indicates that the new version of the Constitution takes into account the interests of all layers of society, that the whole society is united around the idea of building New Uzbekistan, and that our General Assembly is literally the people's Constitution.

The number of articles in the draft constitution has increased from the current 128 to 155, and the number of norms has increased from 275 to 434. That is, the text of our basic law increased by 65% and was updated based on the proposals of our people.

The main innovations included in the Constitution:

- In the constitution, it was determined that Uzbekistan is a sovereign, democratic, legal and social state;
- Strong social protection and care for the needy is defined as an important direction of state policy;
- For the first time in our history, Uzbekistan was defined as a social state. That is, it was confirmed that attention and care for people is the most important duty of the state and society. In the words of President Shavkat Mirziyayev: "the people should serve our people, not the state bodies, but the state bodies". [2:19]
- The right and opportunity to receive education has been expanded, teachers have received constitutional status. Approaches specific to the welfare state are also expressed in many articles and norms related to the field of education. Norms related to education and science are increasing by almost 2 times. In particular, the right of citizens in higher education institutions at the expense of a state grant was strictly defined. According to the information, it can be said that until 2017, the number of state grants for studying in universities only decreased, but in the last 6 years, the situation in this regard has completely changed. The number of scholarship has doubled to 40,000. And for the master's degree, it has increased 5 times. It is clear that the

future of young people is above all else from the changes and reforms. And in this regard, our President Shavkat Mirziyayev is right: “ the most important thing for us is to bring up determined young people who are able to take responsibility for the fate and future of our country, to mobilize all their knowledge and potential in this way. “is a problem”, he did not repeat over and over again. - President Shavkat Mirziyayev said: “ in this world, thinking about people’s pain and worries is the highest criterion of humanity.” [4:18] Of course, these words represent the content of the planned reforms. In the newly revised constitution, the state assumed a number of new obligations to reduce poverty, ensure employment, and protect against unemployment. In general, the norms of the Constitution related to the obligations of the state in the social sphere have been increased by 3 times. For information, last year conditions were created for 50,000 families to get new housing. In the next 2-3 years, efforts are being made to increase this figure to 200,000.

It is no exaggeration to say that the above-mentioned changes and reforms are just "a drop from the sea". Our newly revised Constitution is undoubtedly perfectly structured for the development and upliftment of all aspects. As President Shavkat Mirziyoyev said: "The new version of the Constitution of the Republic of Uzbekistan created a solid foundation for the stable development of statehood, socio-political, socio-economic and judicial-legal spheres." [5:1] At this point, I think it is appropriate to mention the recognition of Professor Didier Mos, a French expert, reporter of the "Jahon" news agency, honorary president of the International Association of Constitutional Law in Paris, regarding our Constitution. Didier Mos admitted to the world that "the Constitution of Uzbekistan is the basis of the country's political stability and development." Of course, it is an honor for us.

Undoubtedly, what we have achieved today is thanks to our Constitution. The Constitution is also a comprehensive document that ensures that a person can live, travel, and think freely as a human being. He reflected his spirit and health. The Constitution is the greatest achievement of our independence. It is such a perfect work that it has answers to all human needs. It contains the concepts of preserving and protecting not only people, but also ordinary trees, nature, blessed places. Therefore, let's respect the Constitution, which is our Basic Law, and follow it

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
